TOURNAMENT RULES

ELIGIBILITY

Only members of the Union County NJ USBC are eligible to compete in this tournament. Non-members living within the jurisdiction of this Association who are not members of another Association may enter by paying the UC NJ USBC certification fee of \$23.00. All entrants must produce their USBC certification card.

AVERAGES

- A. Highest certified 2016-17 Union County average of 21 games or more.
- B. If "A" does not apply, a bowler must use their highest December 15, 2017 certified Union County average, minimum 21 games.
- C. If "A" or "B" does not apply, a bowler must use a scratch average of 230. Summer league or USBC Youth averages will not be accepted.

MULTIPLE ENTRIES

- A. When a bowler participates more than once in the Singles or Doubles event, the first score in these events shall be used for the bowlers all events totals.
- B. In no case shall a bowler place more than once in the Doubles Prize List with the same partner. A bowler may only place once in the Singles Prize list.
- C. Walk In entries will be accepted up to 15 minutes prior to desired squad time.

RULES

USBC Rule 319A-3 shall apply: It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his/her average whether originally submitted by the bowler, his/her team captain or others. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction prior to the completion of the first game bowled of the series shall disqualify the scores if the submitted average is lower than the actual average or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher. USBC Rule 319A (use of composite average), Rule 319A-2 (ten pin rule), Rule 319D (Report of prize winnings) and Rule 319E (Use average during 12 month period) are all waived. The Average Rerating Rule (USBC Rule 319-C) applies throughout this Tournament. This rule allows the Tournament Director to adjust a bowler's entering average. The bowler or bowlers affected have the right to appeal the rerating.

ALL EVENTS

Participation in All Events is optional. This event is conducted on an SCRATCH BASIS only. Those who have paid the required entry fee shall participate in the prize list. However, should a non paid participant win the All Events division, he or she shall be awarded the trophy and the official title, but no cash prize. Prize ratio is at least 1 in 20 for All Events.

OPEN

- CLASS A: Entrants with an average of 200 or higher
- CLASS B: Entrants with an average of 180 to 199
- CLASS C: Entrants with an average of 179 or lower

WOMENS DIVISION

- CLASS A: Entrants with an average of 190 or higher
- CLASS B: Entrants with an average of 160 to 189
- CLASS C: Entrants with an average of 159 or lower

PRIZES AND HANDICAPS

Singles and Doubles Events will be apportioned as follows: 60% for Handicap score prizes and 40% for Actual Score prizes. Bowlers will be eligible for one prize (Handicap or Actual) in each event. Should a bowler's score qualify for both, the bowler shall receive the higher dollar amount of the two. Prize ratio is at least 1 in 10 for Singles and Doubles Events.

CAPTAINS RESPONSIBILITY

The individual whose name appears as the captain on this entry form shall be responsible for the accuracy of all information submitted hereon. Any incorrect information or violation of Tournament Rules may result in the disqualification of the entire entry and forfeiture of entry fees as well as any resultant prize money.
